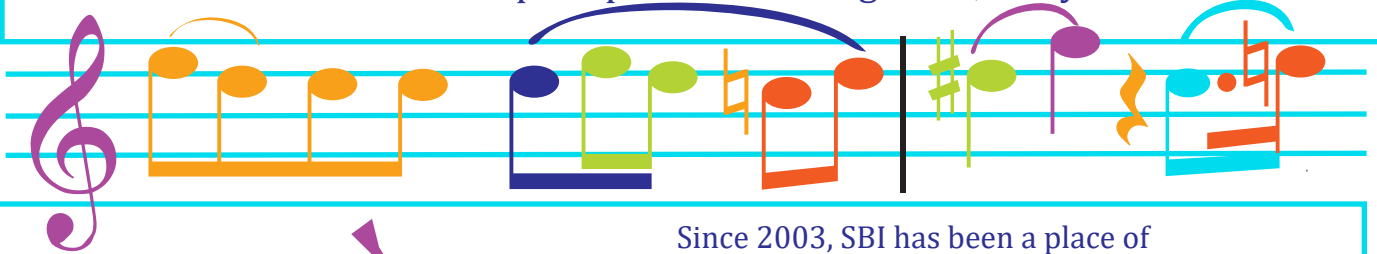

Saint Mark's Episcopal Church - Highland, Maryland



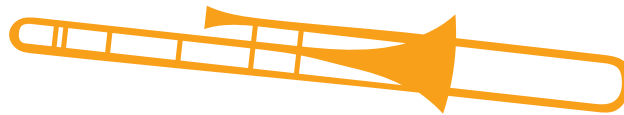

Accepting all brass musicians from grades 5 to 12, with a minimum requirement of one year of school band experience

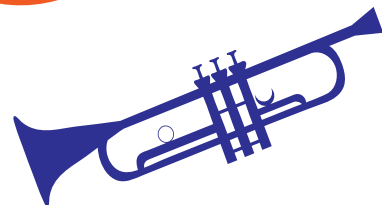
